## And Finally – Going Back in Time...

The Red Lion, a 17<sup>th</sup> century inn is believed to have an earlier history with strong links to the English Civil War through Colonel Francis Hacker who lived at Stathern Hall and who was a churchwarden and constable of the village. Francis Hacker was a regicide who fought against the Royalists in the English Civil War and had a leading role in the execution of Charles I. Hacker was executed when Charles II came to the throne. Certainly, in 1790, a meeting in the Red Lion Inn set out the terms for the Enclosure Act of 1792, which would change the way the village used and owned its land.
